Russ was also the CEO of Mrs. Winner’s Chicken & Biscuits until selling Mrs. Winner’s in May of 2006. Mrs. Winner’s operated 98 company-owned restaurants and supported 21 franchised units in the Southeast.

Mr. Umphenour led RTM to sales revenues of over \$900 million and over 25,000 employees. Mr. Umphenour also serves as a member of the Board of Directors of Triarc Companies, Inc., the parent company of Arby’s Restaurant Group, Inc.
